These terms and conditions may be changed at any time without notice.

• **Registrations (EDJSA)**

1. Registrations will only be accepted with a \$200 non-refundable deposit (ex. Development Squad) and a completed, signed registration form.
2. If full payment has not been made by round 1 the player will be unable to play until full registration has been paid (unless payment arrangements have been made with the club).
3. Grading may be conducted for paid registered players from U10-Colts.
4. Requests for particular teams will be considered by the registrar in consultation with the coaches. The registrar's decision will be final.
5. Players may be added to a waiting list in order of inquiry to be eligible for registration should a position become available.
6. If a team cannot be filled and registration has been paid a full refund will be given to those not placed.
7. New players must supply a copy of proof of age (Birth certificate, Passport etc.), a passport sized ID photo (U9 to Colts only) and a completed blue EDJSA player registration form (available from the registrar).
8. The parent/guardian signing the registration form is responsible for full payment.
9. A player may not be registered with two different soccer associations.

• **Registrations (FSA)**

1. Registrations will only be accepted with a \$200 non-refundable deposit and a completed registration form for players selected after trials. Players will be required to register online with FSA via the myFootball website prior to the start of the season (instructions on how to do this will be provided).
2. If full payment has not been made by round 1 the player will be unable to play until full registration has been paid (unless payment arrangements have been made with the club).
3. Registered mini roos players from U6-U11 will be placed in teams and must register online with FSA via the myFootball website before the start of the season (instructions on how to do this will be provided).
4. A player may not be registered with two different soccer associations.
5. New players for junior competitions will be required to supply a copy of proof of age (Birth certificate, Passport etc.).

• **Payments**

1. Payments shall be accepted by Direct Deposit, Cash, Cheque or Credit card.
2. Cheques are to be made out to "Modbury Vista Soccer Club Inc."
3. A Direct Debit payment itself does not constitute registration, until a registration form is received and accepted by the Registrar.
4. Please note if you are having trouble with payment please refer to the registrar to discuss payment options.

- **Refunds**

1. No refund shall be given for transferring to any other club.
2. All refund requests are to be in writing and addressed to the Secretary prior to round 1.
3. No refund requests will be accepted after round 1.
4. Prior to round 1 if a player no longer wishes to play for Modbury Vista Soccer Club and is not transferring to another club, a refund of 50% may apply.
5. A full refund will apply if Modbury Vista Soccer Club is unable to place a player within a team.
6. **All approved refunds will be issued after round 4 minus the \$200 non-refundable deposit or agreed amount.**

- **Liability**

1. Your child is about to participate in a sport which involves some risk to their safety. If your child participates you will give up your normal legal right to receive compensation if you or your child is injured.
2. You shall not hold Modbury Vista Soccer Club, FSA, Elizabeth & Districts Junior Soccer Association Inc. its member clubs, officials and coaches liable to any legal, ambulance, hospital, dental or medical expenses which may be incurred as a result of injuries sustained whilst playing under the jurisdiction of the said Association.
3. In the event of an accident or emergency that requires your child to receive medical or dental treatment (including ambulance transportation) and you cannot be contacted, you hereby consent to the coach or a Modbury Vista Soccer Club member deciding on the most appropriate medical or dental treatment and you acknowledge that you shall be responsible for the associated costs of such treatment.

- **Medical Condition**

1. It is your responsibility to ensure that your child is able to play and train. Any medical conditions should be discussed with the coach and/or manager.

- **Code of Conduct**

1. You shall abide by the Modbury Vista Soccer Club, FSA or Elizabeth & District Junior Soccer Association's Code of Conduct at all times when associated with any Association sanctioned event.
2. You agree to delegate your authority to the coaches and instructors involved. They may take whatever disciplinary action they deem necessary to ensure the safety, well being and successful conduct of the players as a group or individually.
3. You acknowledge a breach of the Code of Conduct may result in sanctions being imposed by the Club including cancellation of membership with the Modbury Vista Soccer Club.
4. To ensure you are aware of the Code of Conduct your coach will require Code of Conduct document to be reviewed and signed prior to the beginning of the season.
